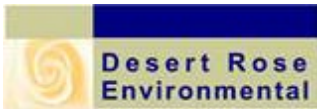
Gary,

In reviewing my files I realized that I had completed a second review of the Gravel Pit (see attached letter dated July 10, 2020). The information that you sent me the other day contained a Spill Prevention Plan with Best Management Practices that meets my second issue in the letter. However, I did not see an updated seeding schedule. I had asked for you to add a legume to the site seeding schedule and increase the broadcast rate to 35 to 40 PLS per acre. I had suggested a couple of legumes that are native to the area including Cider Milkvetch, Falcata Alfalfa, or Sweet Clover.

If you have updated the seeding schedule could you direct me to where I can review it. If not, then please provide an updated seeding schedule. Thanks!
