**Directions to South Fork Park (4988 South Fork Rd Provo, UT)**

From Orem: Head up Provo Canyon Road (US-189N) for approximately 5.5 miles. Make a right (south) onto South Fork Road. This turn is before Vivian Park. Head up S Fk Rd for 1.7 miles. South Fork Park will be on the right. We will meet under Pavilion #1.





**Directions from South Fork Park to CUWCD Utah Valley Drinking Water Plant:**

Head west on S Fork Rd and turn left onto Provo Canyon Rd (US-189) for 5.7 miles. Bear right onto 800 North at stoplight near mouth of the canyon and go west 1.1 miles. Turn right (north) onto 800 East and go 0.9 miles. Turn right onto Cascade Dr and proceed to the end of the road at the entrance gate. The plant is located at 1120 East Cascade Drive on the bench above Orem.
